Cost of living & travel in **Toronto**



- Standard city one-way bus ticket: 3.25 CAD
- Monthly ticket pass (bus/train): 156 CAD
- Taxi fare: 23 CAD (8km)



- Standard pint of beer: 7 CAD
- 3-course meal for 2 people: 82.50 CAD



- Typical hotel for 2 adults: 187 CAD (per night)
- Average rent for 2-bedroom apartment: 2,250 CAD (per month)



- Doctor's visit: 74 CAD
