## Cost of living & travel in Dubrovnik



- Standard city one-way bus ticket: 15 HRK
- Monthly transport pass: 250 – 350 HRK
- Taxi fare:  
25 HRK (initial charge); 8 HRK (per km)



- Standard pint of beer: 20 – 30 HRK
- 3-course meal for 2 people:  
400 – 650 HRK



- Typical hotel for 2 adults:  
500 – 700 HRK (per night)
- Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment:  
4,800 – 5,500 HRK (per month)



- 15 Minute doctor's visit: 180 – 250 HRK

Costs are based on average in Dubrovnik, Croatia in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
