Cost of living & travel in Stockholm



- **Standard city one-way ticket:** 38 SEK
- **Monthly transport pass:** 900 SEK
- **Taxi fare:** 45 SEK (initial standard fare) + 520 SEK /hour + 13 SEK/km



- **Standard pint of beer:** 60 – 75 SEK
- **3-course meal for 2 people:** 780 – 900 SEK



- **Typical hotel for 2 adults:** 950 – 1200 SEK (per night)
- **Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment:** 11,000 – 16,000 SEK (per month)



- **Doctor's visit:** 200 SEK

Costs are based on average in Stockholm in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
