# Cost of living & travel in Bogotá



- Standard city one-way bus ticket: 2,500 COP
- Taxi fare: 5,000 COP (initial charge); 6,500 COP (per km)



- Standard pint of beer: 5,000 COP
- 3-course meal for 2 people: 80,000 COP



- Typical hotel for 2 adults: 152,000 – 224,000 COP (per night)
- Average rent for 2-bedroom apartment:
   1,200,000 1,900,000 COP (per month)



• Doctor's visit: 84,000 COP

Costs are based on average in Bogotá, Colombia in December 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
