### Cost of living & travel in Mexico City



- Standard bus ticket: 6 MXN
- Monthly transport pass: 380 – 450 MXN
- Taxi fare: 50 MXN (initial standard fare)
  20 MXN (per km)



- Typical hotel for 2 adults: 750 – 900 MXN (per night)
- Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment: 10,000 – 14,000 MXN (per month)



- Standard pint of beer: 40 – 50 MXN
- 3-course meal for 2 people: 750 – 900 MXN



Doctor's visit:
 500 – 1,200 MXN (15 mins)

Costs are based on average in Mexico City in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
