## Cost of living & travel in Istanbul



- Standard bus ticket: 4 7 TRY
- Monthly transport pass: 317 TRY
- Taxi fare: 5.55 TRY (initial charge); 3.45 TRY (per km) – cash only



- Typical hotel for 2 adults: 570 - 995 TRY (per night)
- Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment: 2,779–3,816 TRY (per month)



- Standard pint of beer: 15 - 25 TRY
- 3-course meal for 2 people: 150 - 250 TRY



• Doctor's visit: 245 TRY

Costs are based on average in Istanbul, Turkey in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
